

Soaker-Poker

Create the Game:

1. Grab a fairly large plastic mixing bowl (the one we use is 12 inches across the mouth) either from your own kitchen or any store that sells house wares. It must be tapered so that the bottom is a smaller diameter than the top.
2. Next, head over to your local craft store (bring the plastic mixing bowl) and find the Styrofoam rings section. You'll find many different sizes, and they are very inexpensive (ours cost 48 cents). Look for one that will fit over the bottom of the bowl on the outside and fits up to about the halfway point.

Congratulations! You just made your very own, genuine "Hot Tub Floaty-Pot" to hold your poker chips or whatever else you are using to keep score!

3. We made our own floating chips by buying rubber numerals and letters (you can get a big pack of them for a couple of dollars) from any children's store. These are designed to float in a bathtub or stick to the walls if slapped against them, and they are different colors just like poker chips. I cut them into little round poker chips and now I have chips that float around the tub, stay clean and don't scratch the acrylic!
4. Now, swing by any one of our stores, and pick up a deck of waterproof playing cards (Yes, you read that correctly!). You are almost ready to go!

Playing the Game:

1. Play Soaker-Poker!
2. Remember to stack your winnings on the filter lid as you go (Please use a rubber placemat if you are using real coins so that you don't scratch the lid!), so that everyone in the tub can be reminded of how bad they are losing!
